You will learn how to do the following in the workplace:

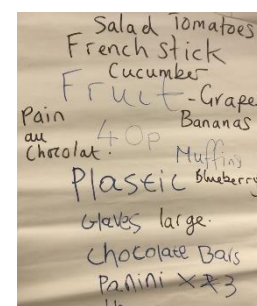
- Look and act the part, depending on your job role

- Plan and update the café menu each week and write a shopping list





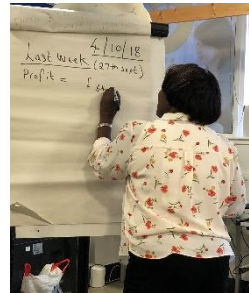
## Pathways to Employment - Accredited Course
